From the Engadine breakfast buffet to the gourmet dinner in an Art Nouveau ambience, in Saratz the guests are spoiled with culinary delights. Small highlights and audience favorites: coffee and cake at the hotel bar, the Thursday concerts on Switzerland's smallest stage in the Pitschna Scena and last but not least the two legendary sun terraces with a view of the Roseg Glacier.

The wellness world of the Hotel Saratz leaves nothing to be desired. From the indoor pool with perhaps the most beautiful view ever to the largest outdoor pool in the Engadine. In addition to the well-known spa features, there are also more special beauty and spa treatments such as rhassoul, honey peeling and much more.

It starts with a small aperitif on arrival with refreshing towels. The minibar drinks are included in the Saratz, and a Nespresso coffee machine and teas are waiting in the rooms. Swisscom WiFi is fast and of course free of charge. Various newspapers and magazines are available in the lobby. In summer and autumn, Saratz guests can use mountain railways, trains and buses within the network area free of charge for two nights or more. In winter, the "Sleep & Ski" ski pass can be obtained from reception.
